- 1. Approve adding Gaiser Appraisal Services to the quailed pool for real estate appraisal services.
- 2. Approve the negotiation and execution of the Agreements and a Lease for the items listed in memos "a" through "h":
 - a. Reimbursement Agreement with Middlesex Township Municipal Authority to reimburse the Township the costs to perform the required facility relocation work necessary for the total reconstruction project from MP 220.00 to MP 227.00 (MP 226.7092, Station 710+25); for a not-to-exceed amount of \$87,750.00;
 - Reimbursement Agreement with PECO Energy Co. to reimburse PECO the costs to perform the required facility relocation work necessary for the I-95/I-276 Interchange project; at a not-to-exceed amount of \$2,290,559.00;
 - c. Lease Agreement and Settlement for back rent with Adams Outdoor Advertising for a billboard located on Commission owned surplus parcel in Lehigh County;
 - Lease Agreement at \$4,000.00 per year for 5-years, with the option to extend the lease an additional 5-years, which will include a 3% per year increase during the second 5-year term;

Acquisition of Right-of-Way #7144-C (County of Bucks), a partial take parcel necessary for the I-95/I-276 Interchange, Section D, project, by authorizing payment of \$15,100.00 to the County of Bucks, representing fair market value; authorize the appropriate Commission officials to execute the agreement of sale; authorize the payment of additional statutory damages as calculated by the Right-of-Way Administrator and approved by the Chief Counsel; and payment of damages to the property owner is contingent upon its delivery of a deed prepared by the Legal Department;
 - c. Acquisition of Right-of-Way #7151-A (County of Bucks), a partial take parcel necessary for the I-95/I-276 Interchange, Section D, project, by authorizing payment of \$500.00 to the County of Bucks, representing fair market value; authorize the appropriate Commission officials to execute the agreement of sale; authorize the payment of additional statutory damages as calculated by the Right-of-Way Administrator and approved by the Chief Counsel; and payment of damages to the property owner is contingent upon its delivery of a deed prepared by the Legal Department;
 - d. Acquisition of Right-of-Way #3366-A (Hempt Bros., Inc.), a partial take parcel necessary for the total reconstruction from MP 242.00 to MP 245.00, by authorizing payment of \$128,367.00 to Hempt Bros., Inc., representing fair market value and pro-rated taxes; authorize the appropriate Commission officials to execute the agreement of sale, and other documents as may be required for closing, including the required conservation easement; authorize the payment of additional statutory damages as calculated by the Right-of-Way Administrator and approved by the Chief Counsel; and payment of fair market value to the property owner is contingent upon the delivery of a conservation easement as drafted by the Legal Department;
 - e. Acquisition of Right-of-Way #3366-B (Hempt Bros., Inc.), a partial take parcel necessary for the total reconstruction from MP 242.00 to MP 245.00, by authorizing payment of \$197,167.00 to Hempt Bros., Inc., representing fair market value and pro-rated taxes; authorize the appropriate Commission officials to execute the agreement of sale, and other documents as may be required for closing, including the required conservation easement; authorize the payment of additional statutory damages as calculated by the Right-of-Way Administrator and approved by the Chief Counsel; and payment of fair

market value to the property owner is contingent upon the delivery of a conservation easement as drafted by the Legal Department;

- f. Adopt the Proposed Property Acquisition Resolution for Right-of-Way #7152-C (Joseph and Mary Ponczek), a partial take parcel necessary for the I-95/I-276 Interchange project; authorize payment of estimated just compensation in the amount of \$500.00 to Stevens & Lee, PC, escrow agent; and authorize payment of additional statutory damages as calculated by the Right-of-Way Administrator and approved by the Chief Counsel;
- g. Execute the required Declarations of Restrictive Covenants, for portions of Right-of-Way #14205-A (*Peluso*) and Right-of-Way #14070-D (*Red Raven*) previously acquired for the total reconstruction project from MP 40.00 to MP 48.00, to construct wetland and stream mitigation sites; and authorize the preparation of the documents by the Legal Department;
- h. Execute the deed, for the previously acquired Right-of-Way #7085-A (*Keystone Turf Club, Inc. and Bensalem Racing Assoc., Inc.*) for the I-95/I-276 Interchange project, to transfer the portion of the former *Tarlini property* (upon which the Turf Club's private sewer line is located) to the Turf Club; and authorize the preparation of the documents by the Legal Department;
- i. Acquisition of Right-of-Way #1031-R23 (Turnpike Creamery Partners, LLC), a total take parcel necessary for the replacement of the SR 601 bridge at MP 110.12, by authorizing payment of \$835,094.00 to David J. Puzak, Esquire, escrow agent, representing fair market value, recording fees and mortgage satisfaction; authorize the appropriate Commission officials to execute the agreement of sale; authorize payment of additional statutory damages as calculated by the Right-of-Way Administrator and approved by the Chief Counsel; and payment of damages to the property owner is contingent upon its delivery of a deed prepared by the Legal Department;

Grant of a drainage easement to *TB-BDN Plymouth Apartments, L.P (Plymouth)*. adjacent to the Mid-County Interchange, Ramp H, as required by Plymouth's environmental permitting and land development plan; and authorize the appropriate Commission officials to execute the drainage easement as drafted by the Legal Department.
